As of June 16, 2022, according to the Centers for Disease Control and Prevention there have been 1,007,964 people who have died from COVID-19 in the United States.

It is overwhelming that over 1 million people died from a small virus. You may know someone who died from COVID. You may have been infected by COVID. You may know someone who is still battling the side effects from the virus. The numbers of deaths and these experiences don't lie. Yet many people believe that COVID was a hoax.

It's been over 2 years that the world has been living with this pandemic. Regardless of the 1 million deaths from COVID-19 many people still continue to believe it is a lie.
