2023 Synod Assembly Highlights

Dear Lehigh Mission District,

After three years, the 36th Annual Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod Assembly of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America met in person at Kalahari Resorts in the Poconos with over 400 voting delegates present.

The following resolutions were adopted by the Assembly:

RESPONSIBLE MONEY MANAGEMENT IN CONGREGATIONS

Resolved, that the Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod in assembly recommends to all of its congregations that

- 1. There be a complete disclosure to the members of those congregations the assets and liabilities of the congregations so that there is transparency concerning what the congregations own and what the congregations owe;
- 2. There be safeguards in the way money is handled in the congregations so that, for one example, at least two unrelated persons count all incoming money;
- 3. There be safeguards in the way money is spent, such as requiring two signatures on every check with those signatures being added after the checks have been prepared; (There are an additional 4 more points under this resolution. Due to space in this newsletter this author invites readers to read the remaining points found on the synod website.)

CHAPLAINCY AT DIAKON FACILITIES

Resolved, that the Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod in Assembly urge that Diakon Lutheran Social Ministries Agency of the Evangelical Lutheran Church in America commit to providing full time Chaplaincy in each of its Senior Living & Housing facilities.

LAND ACKNOWLEDGMENT

Resolved, that this statement be placed on display prominent location at the Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod office, on the Synod website, and in appropriate Synod publication, as well as read at the beginning of Synod-wide gathering; and be further

Resolved that all congregation camps, institutions of learning, and other partner organizations affiliated with Northeastern Pennsylvania Synod be encouraged to likewise adopt and use this or a similar statement; and be it further

Resolved that this assembly commits itself and strongly advises all those within this church body to become aware of and involved with the ELCA Truth and Healing Movement, and to use these opportunities to learn the true history and ongoing realities of indigenous people.
